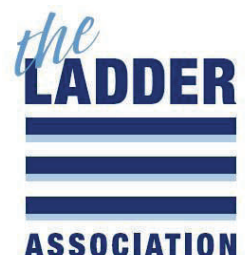
COURSE OBJECTIVES
